



# Project Update

**CAUTION: CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OCCURRING 24/7  
ALONG THE LILLOOET RIVER FSR**

KM	Activity along the Lillooet River FSR
KM 21.5-23	Transmission line crews working along right-of-way.
KM 38	<b>Caution:</b> High traffic area at the entrance to the Camp Road (Pebble Mainline).
KM 38 - 48	Concrete and rock trucks will be hauling day and night from KM 38 along the FSR and turning into the two powerhouse locations (i.e. KM 38.5 and KM 41.2) and Upper Lillooet River Intake area (KM 48). <b>Drive cautiously in this area.</b>
KM 38.5	Formwork, rebar and concrete works at the Boulder Creek HEF Powerhouse. Tunnelling continuing at the Boulder Creek HEF. Blasting will occur daily.
KM 39.5 Athel Main	Construction of the Boulder Creek Crane Pad and diversion. Blasting will occur daily. Day and night shifts working. As of Nov. 1 <sup>st</sup> , the MFLNRO has mandated that a gate be installed and closed until June 15 <sup>th</sup> to prevent unauthorized motorized vehicles from entering the Mountain goat Ungulate Winter Range. The gate is located at the 500m buffer from the UWR which is approximately KM 3 along the Athel Mainline Road.
KM 41.2	Formwork, rebar and concrete works at the Upper Lillooet River HEF Powerhouse
KM 42	Bulk excavation of the penstock right-of-way
KM 44	Winterization and shutdown activities commencing at the downstream tunnel portal
KM 48	Construction activities at the Upper Lillooet River HEF intake on both north and south sides. Blasting will occur daily. Day and night shifts working.
Road Name	Activities associated with Transmission Line (South side)
Lillooet South FSR	KM 2: Road building and hand falling up Branch S200 road toward Black Creek
Ryan River FSR	No activity at this time.
Salmon Main	Road upgrades along Salmon Main Road.
Pemberton Creek Main	Road upgrade works and right-of-way clearing. Log loading and hauling will also take place.

**Lillooet River FSR - general updates on other industrial users**

- Processing logs and active hauling along the Lillooet River FSR, Lillooet South FSR and spur roads.
- Pumice trucks hauling daily.
