All work sites will be operational

KM	Activity along the Lillooet River FSR
<b>KM 38</b>	<p><b>PLEASE BE ADVISED:</b> A Check Point Booth is in place 24 hr/day.</p> <p>All vehicles are asked to slow down, stop and check-in with the attendance for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Landslide Risk Hazard Level</li> <li>• Road Conditions</li> <li>• Site Safety</li> <li>• Work Site Update</li> </ul> <p>You will be asked to provide your name/plate number on the way through the work site and on the way out. This is to ensure that information is provided to the public about the construction site and to protect public safety.</p> <p>Your cooperation is appreciated.</p>
<b>KM 38 – 41.2</b>	<p>Concrete and rock trucks will be hauling from KM 38 along the FSR and turning into the two powerhouse locations (i.e. KM 38.5 and KM 41.2).</p> <p><b>Drive cautiously in this area – especially KM 39.7 to Km 41.2 as this is a narrow section of road (one-way traffic at a time).</b></p>
<b>KM 38.5</b>	<p>Formwork, rebar and concrete works at the Boulder Creek HEF Powerhouse.</p> <p>Tunnelling at the Boulder Creek HEF. Blasting will occur daily.</p>
<b>KM 39.5</b>	<p>Boulder Creek HEF Intake works active</p>
<b>Athel Mainline Road</b>	<p>Road maintenance and hauling along the Athel Mainline Road.</p>
<b>KM 41.2</b>	<p>Formwork, rebar and concrete works at the Upper Lillooet River HEF Powerhouse.</p>
<b>KM 48</b>	<p>Upper Lillooet River HEF Intake works active. Blasting will commence May 9th</p>
Road Name	Activities associated with Transmission Line (South side)
<b>Lillooet South FSR</b>	<p>KM 2: Transmission line stringing up Branch S200 beyond Black Creek with helicopter.</p>
<b>Ryan River FSR</b>	<p>No activity at this time.</p>
<b>Ryan South Main</b>	<p>Road construction and upgrades along Ryan South Main.</p>
<b>Miller Creek area</b>	<p>Active falling and machine work KM 3-5</p>
<b>Pemberton Creek area</b>	<p>Active falling and road construction starting May 9<sup>th</sup></p>
<b>Rutherford Creek FSR</b>	<p>Active falling on slopes about FSR supported by helicopter. Helicopter staging area near KM 2, use caution in this area</p>

## Lillooet River FSR - general updates on other industrial users

- Road maintenance along the Lillooet River FSR continuing, expect minor delays.
- Road capping material is stockpiled along road between KM 24-30 creating narrow sections. Drive cautiously in these areas.

### Penstock Delivery starting May 21<sup>st</sup>

- There will be 5 trucks per day carrying the 3.6 m diameter penstock through Pemberton.
- Trucking will continue until approximately mid-August.
