KM	Activity along the Lillooet River FSR
KM 37.5	Check Point Booth is in place 24 hr/day
KM 38.5	Tunnelling at the Boulder Creek HEF. Blasting will occur daily
KM 39	Access road to Boulder Creek Intake. Works ongoing with blasting occurring daily.
KM 41.2	Upper Lillooet River HEF Powerhouse site open
KM 42	Lillooet River Trail is now OPEN. Please be advised that the route has been impacted from deadfall across the trail, which will be cleaned up in the next few weeks. Temporary signage and flagging are in place to route hikers through the area. PLEASE NOTE: the trailhead is an active construction zone so please use caution in this area. An additional parking area has been established at KM 41.8 when the main parking at KM 42.2 is full. DO NOT PARK ANYWHERE ALONG THE FSR
KM 42-44	Upper Lillooet River HEF Penstock works ongoing
KM 44	Upper Lillooet River HEF Downstream Tunnel Portal site open
KM 47	Upper Lillooet River HEF Intake and Upstream Tunnel Portal site open

Lillooet South FSR	Helicopter staging at KM 4.5 Please use caution in this area.
Ryan River FSR	No activities at this time.
Ryan South Main	Road construction.
Miller Bench FSR	Road construction and processing timber along FSR.
Pemberton Creek area	Ground preparation including blasting.
